## GRIEVE FAMILY SAUVIGNON BLANC 2018

**95pts:** "Brought up in barrels, the 2018 Sauvignon Blanc Estate is a big step up and has gorgeous notes of lemon grass, buttered citrus, green almonds, and salty minerality. Rich, medium to full-bodied, and textured, yet still with gorgeous acidity, this is a brilliant, layered wine to drink over the coming 2-4 years. I wouldn't be surprised to see it keep longer as well." – *Jeb Dunnuck* 

**93pts** "The 2018 Sauvignon Blanc Estate needs a little swirling to reveal notes of fresh grapefruit, lemon curd and passion fruit with hints of honeysuckle and mandarin peel. The medium-bodied palate delivers intense tropical and citrus flavors with a compellingly oily texture and a crisp backbone, finishing long and perfumed. This wine was fermented and aged for 17 months in 80% French oak barrels (60% new) and 20% concrete egg." – *Lisa Perrotti-Brown, Wine Advocate*
