TASTING NOTE

Mouthfilling richness, deft balance and seamless integration are the hallmarks of Grieve Family Estate Sauvignon Blanc. The near-perfect 2018 growing season promoted an incredibly vivid core of melon and stone fruit buoyed by bright acidity and finessed by a lilting, wet stone impression that lingers on the long, refreshing finish.

95pts: "Brought up in barrels, the 2018 Sauvignon Blanc Estate is a big step up and has gorgeous notes of lemon grass, buttered citrus, green almonds, and salty minerality. Rich, medium to full-bodied, and textured, yet still with gorgeous acidity, this is a brilliant, layered wine to drink over the coming 2-4 years.
