NAPA VALLEY

TASTING NOTE

The 2019 vintage of our Double Eagle Red made by Philippe and Maayan was produced from grapes sourced from two very exclusive vineyard sites. The grapes were vinified individually by block to maximize the individual character of each vineyard in the final blend. The lots were fermented in stainless steel tanks with an average of 22 days on the skins before aging for 18 months in French oak. The final blend displays the rich, fruit-driven character that is the signature of our select valley-floor sites.

REVIEW

94pts: "A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot sourced from Mill Creek Vineyard in St Helena and Skelenger Vineyard in Oakville. Toasty oak aromas with a sheen of vanilla crème brûlée, brandied cherries and charred herbs. Layered flavours of blackberry, black cherry and raspberry give way to coffee, scorched earth and dried flowers. Full-bodied with chewy, muscular tannins that resolve on a long savoury finish of cocoa and black olive. – *Decanter Magazine, Jonathan Cristaldi*
