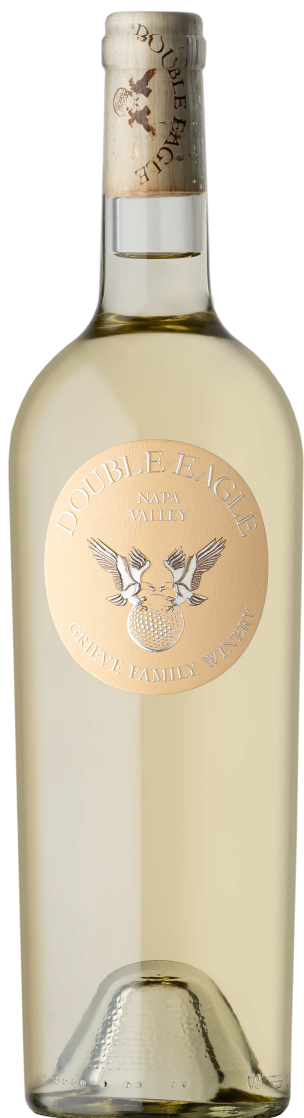

TASTING NOTE

Opening with bright citrus zest and ripe tropical fruit, the wine's sharp fruit core takes on added richness and texture on the palate, riding an elegant acid lift through the long, lively finish.

REVIEW

96pts "The celebrated winemaking team of Philippe Melka and Maayan Koschitzky crafted a sensational wine from grapes grown on the Grieve Family's organically farmed vineyard in Napa's cool-climate Lovall Valley. Fermented and aged eight months in 23% French oak and 77% concrete egg, this is a limited edition white (633 cases). The perfume performs as if you are experiencing a live-action slicing of ripe pineapple with a whiff of salt water taffy. A floral echo enhances waves of peach and papaya, lit up by bracing acidity and a formidable minerality. The finish of salted tangerine is memorable."
