## REVIEW

**94pts:** "A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot sourced from Mill Creek Vineyard in St Helena and Skelenger Vineyard in Oakville. Toasty oak aromas with a sheen of vanilla crème brûlée, brandied cherries and charred herbs. Layered flavours of blackberry, black cherry and raspberry give way to coffee, scorched earth and dried flowers. Full-bodied with chewy, muscular tannins that resolve on a long savoury finish of cocoa and black olive. – *Jonathan Cristaldi, Decanter Magazine*

**93pts:** "This is densely packed with dark fig and black currant reduction flavors, with cocoa, loam, espresso crema and dark tobacco notes. A bit stolid at first but this unwinds slowly, showing flickers of violet and anise on the finish. For fans of the muscular style." – *James Molesworth, Wine Spectator*
