



## 2020 GRIEVE FAMILY ESTATE SAUVIGNON BLANC NAPA VALLEY

## TASTING NOTE

Mouthfilling richness, deft balance and seamless integration are the hallmarks of Grieve Family Estate Sauvignon Blanc. The near-perfect 2019 growing season promoted an incredibly vivid core of melon and stone fruit buoyed by bright acidity and finessed by a lilting, wet stone impression that lingers on the long, refreshing finish.

## REVIEW

**95pts:** "The 2020 Grieve Family Winery Sauvignon Blanc is brilliant and certainly up with the top examples of this variety in California. Revealing a vivid gold hue (with just a hint of green in the color), it has a classic, Bordeaux Blanc-like bouquet of crushed citrus, chalky minerality, minty herbs, and green almonds, with classy background oak. This bright, juicy, vibrant, medium-bodied Sauvignon Blanc has terrific acidity, again, this incredible sense of minerality, and a clean, dry finish that keeps you coming back to the glass. I love it today, yet I suspect it will evolve for 7-8 years, if not longer, in cold cellars. The wine is 100% Sauvignon Blanc aged 16 months in 60% new French oak." – *Jeb Dunnuck*
