

96pts “The celebrated winemaking team of Philippe Melka and Maayan Koschitzky crafted a sensational wine from grapes grown on the Grieve Family’s organically farmed vineyard in Napa’s cool-climate Lovall Valley. Fermented and aged eight months in 23% French oak and 77% concrete egg, this is a limited edition white (633 cases). The perfume performs as if you are experiencing a live-action slicing of ripe pineapple with a whiff of salt water taffy. A floral echo enhances waves of peach and papaya, lit up by bracing acidity and a formidable minerality. The finish of salted tangerine is memorable.” – *Meridith May, Tasting Panel & The Somm Journal*

93pts “Distinctive, with a fresh, fragrant note of wintergreen up front, leading to lemon curd, honeysuckle and a hint of beeswax, pickled ginger and notes of yuzu and fresh-cut apple. Shows a smooth, silky body, with mouthwatering acidity.” – *MaryAnn Worobiec, Wine Spectator*
