2021 DOUBLE EAGLE RED BLEND NAPA VALLEY



VINTAGE

The 2021 growing season was noted for being dry, cool and long, an ideal recipe for maximum fruit expression and balance. Warm weather early in the season led to a good fruit set, while moderate temperatures from veraison through harvest extended the hangtime, allowing grapes to mature slowly and evenly.

WINEMAKING

The grapes for our 2021 Double Eagle Red were picked in the early morning hours and transported immediately to the winery, where they were vinified individually by lot and fermented in stainless steel tanks with an average of 17 days on the skins. The wine was racked to French oak barrels for 18 months aging before being bottled unfiltered and unfined.

TASTING NOTES

Intense color and expressive nose, notes of plums and red fruit mixed with fresh herbs (Bay & Sage) with hint of barrel toast and coco. On the palate the wine is full body with freshness and vibrancy, the wine has a dark mid palate with dark fruit and hints of chocolate with framed tannins and long finish
